

Frequently Asked Questions

What is my room assignment? When will I receive it?

Room assignments are made by UHCS management in July and a final confirmation letter of your assignment should arrive at your permanent address around July 31. International students should allow three to four weeks for delivery. This confirmation includes information regarding which apartment and bedroom you will be living in; your College Suites' address and phone number; and the name of your roommates.

Can I contact my roommate before we move in?

If you have one or more roommates, those names and email addresses will appear on your final confirmation letter. If authorized, feel free to write your roommate(s) before you arrive. It is our policy to not share telephone numbers or permanent addresses.

What size is the bedroom?

8.5 feet x 12 feet with 5 electrical outlets

What furniture comes in a bedroom?

Each bedroom comes equipped with a standard twin mattress with a boxed bed frame, desk with 3 drawers and keyboard tray, desk chair, 6-drawer dresser, small wardrobe closet, window blinds, Ethernet hookup, local telephone service, cable television with HBO.

What will I need to bring to complete my bedroom?

You will need a Cat 5 cable, small television, computer, and telephone; all bedding needs, pillows, alarm clock, floor lamp or desk lamp, flashlight, surge protector, etc.

How can I change my apartment and/or bedroom assignment?

You can type up a written request to change rooms and will be placed on a waiting list. If a room in your requested apartment opens up, you will then be placed if all other roommates approve.

How can I request a double bedroom apartment?

You can type up a written request to be put on the two bedroom wait list. If a two bedroom apartment should become available and you're next on the list, you will then be placed.

Please note that it's important **NOT** to switch bedrooms with roommates as you will be held responsible for the room originally assigned. Officially make the change through the rental office.

The common area of the apartment is furnished with a sofa, sofa chair, end table, TV stand, table w/ 3 chairs, standard refrigerator, stove, oven, microwave, and a garbage disposal. You will need your own supply of food, garbage can, garbage bags, and eating/drinking utensils.

Each quad apartment has two bathrooms. One on each side and is shared by two roommates. You must provide your own toiletries. 1 ply toilet paper is suggested as the toilets in use are code enforced water conservers.

Each apartment has its own thermostat that controls the air conditioning and forced hot air heating unit.

It is important to respect the common and/or shared areas just as you would have your roommates do unto you. **Be clean. Be responsible.**

Suggested items to bring:

- Television (small for room)
- Telephone
- Head phones for stereo/computer
- Cat 5 Cable
- Laundry supplies
- Laundry basket (great for moving too!)
- Quarters (laundry, vending)
- Clothes hangers
- Pillows, standard twin linens
- bath towels and face cloths
- Toiletries and bathroom basket
- Bathroom garbage can
- Shower curtain
- Bath robe
- Alarm clock
- Cups, plates, silverware
- Garbage can for room & kitchen
- Garbage bags
- Desk or floor lamp (non-combustible or plastic)
- Flashlight
- Surge protector (no extension cords allowed)
- Tension rod to hang curtains (blinds provided)
- Cleaning supplies
- Shower sandals
- Poster putty (for pictures and posters)
- Do not use nails, tacks or tape.

- A dolly or wagon to assist you in moving
- School supplies
- Address book/email addresses
- Health card/immunization chart
- Surge protectors (no extension cords)

PROVIDED:

- Laundry rooms on floor #2 and #3
- Soda and snack vending machines
- Change machine
- Book of stamp machine
- ATM machine

DO NOT BRING:

- Pets
- Toaster ovens
- BBQs or hot plates
- Refrigerators larger than 3.0 amps and 4.0 cubic ft
- Candles, potpourri burners
- Weapons of any type
- Room heating devices
- Hazardous chemicals
- Alcohol/drugs
- Musical instruments
